PRINCETON ATTORNEY HANAN M. ISAACS TO LEAD GENERAL SESSION AT STATEWIDE CONFERENCE ON “DAMAGES”

Princeton, NJ (October 16, 2007) – Many think that legal injury is all about “show me the money.” But pros in the field know that a successful verdict is the product of many factors. Princeton attorney Hanan M. Isaacs will lead the General Session on Direct and Cross Examination of Financial Experts at the second annual Litigation Support/Damages Conference. “Damages represent the hidden side of many cases, and it shouldn’t be that way,” says Hanan Isaacs. “At the end of the day,” he continues, “society translates harms and wrongs into dollars and cents. Often, that is the only measure of justice that clients receive for their pain and suffering, and to compensate them for wrongdoing by others.” Concludes Isaacs, “The professional community has to be proficient about asking for damages, defending against them, and carefully measuring them,” he said.

This conference will be of major interest to trial lawyers, judges, mediators, arbitrators, CPA’s, and those who have served or wish to serve as testifying experts. It will cover topics such as Lost Profits/Lost Value; Contrasting Approaches to Lost-Profits Analysis; and Smoking Guns in Electronic Discovery. Colleagues who share a common interest in litigation support and forensic accounting will spend the day learning and networking.

Hanan Isaacs, recently listed in *Best Lawyers in America*® for the third year in a row, will moderate a stellar group. The General Session features Robert Dunn, J.D., a national leading expert on damages and author of *Recovery of Damages for Lost Profits*; *Recovery of Damages of Fraud*; and *Winning with Expert Witnesses in Commercial Litigation*. The panel of commentators will include the Honorable Joel Rosen, US Magistrate Judge in the District of New Jersey (retired), who is now “Of Counsel” at Montgomery McCracken Walker & Rhoads; the Honorable M. Allan Vogelson, NJ Superior Court, Chancery Division-Camden County (retired), presently “Of Counsel” at Parker McKay; Ian Meklinsky, Esq., of Fox Rothschild; and Vincent Gentile, Esq., of Drinker Biddle.
