**NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED LAWYER HANAN M. ISAACS NAMED
TO THE BOARD OF THE COALITION FOR PEACE ACTION**

Princeton, NJ (April 26, 2006) – Princeton attorney Hanan M. Isaacs, recently selected by his peers to be included in The Best Lawyers in America®, has been named to Princeton’s Coalition for Peace Action Board of Directors. The Coalition for Peace Action (CFPA), founded in 1980, is a grassroots citizens organization which brings together people of all ages, backgrounds, professions, and political persuasions in support of global abolition of nuclear weapons, a peace economy, and a halt to weapons trafficking at home and abroad.

According to Mr. Isaacs, “I was happy to be selected to serve on the Coalition Board, because the organization’s values and mine are the same. I am for nuclear disarmament, gun control, and the establishment of a peace economy rather than a permanent war economy. I also believe in firmly establishing voter verified electronic balloting so our most precious civil right is protected for the future. I also disapprove of torture and rendition of prisoners, whether they are prisoners of war or not. Our country can and must do better, both at home and abroad, if we expect to be viewed going forward as the world’s last and best hope.”

The Coalition sponsors an Annual Conference and Interfaith Service for Peace, as well as a Membership Dinner and Gathering with prominent speakers and an annual Concert for Peace with performers including Pete Seeger, Peter Yarrow, Baba Olatunji. The Coalition also publishes and distributes non-partisan voter guides, lobbies, and provides public witness through vigils and rallies. The Coalition recently sponsored a dinner at which Daniel Ellsberg, of Watergate fame, was the featured speaker.

Coalition sponsors include nationally and locally well known people such as Harry Belafonte, Freeman Dyson, Noam Chomsky, Marian Wright Edelman, Andrew Young, Assemblyman W. Reed Gusciora, writer John McPhee, Reverend Doctor William Sloane Coffin, as well as Phyllis Marchand, Mayor, Princeton Township.

Hanan M.
